(b) Section 551.074- Personnel Matters - Appointment of Interim City Secretary.

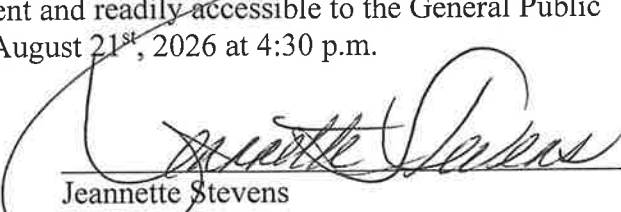
Item No. III: Reconvene into Open Session to consider and/or take action on Executive Session Agenda Deliberations.
